The IRS is reporting that they have resolved the delay with acknowledgements from Thursday, April 11th through Friday, April 12th. The IRS has stated that Linked Fed/State returns should be Made Available for state retrieval.

This has affected Arizona's ability to get new submissions and reconcile acknowledgements. If you have submitted an Arizona return after Thursday, April 11th, Arizona may not have received your submission. Arizona has begun retrieving returns and sending acknowledgements.

Timeliness – Please Note

- Returns and/or payments for the tax due submitted on or before April 15th will be considered timely.
- Returns and/or payments for the tax due corrected and resubmitted during the correction period (April 15th - 20th) will also be considered timely.
